Cooperative Education - Grade 11, COP3X2 (2 Credit), COP3X4 (4 Credit)

Cooperative Education offers a unique opportunity for students to gain hands on experience in a working environment, while satisfying high school diploma requirements. A co-op placement in the community can open doors to further employment as well as give important insight into future career choices. It also provides valuable experiences that could enhance a student's acceptance into college and university programs. A Cooperative Education course can be linked to any other high school course and is identified by the linked course code on the student's transcript.

Note: To apply for a co-op experience, just identify your interest in coop (one, two or four credit package) in your course selections and you will be contacted by the Co-op Department.
